# + Islamabad & Lahore (16days / 14 nights)

This unique Northern Pakistan autumn tour will take you to the beautiful valley of Northern Pakistan at the time of the year when it looks its best. Autumn is a time when the landscape of **Northern Pakistan** looks like a painting, the trees throughout the valley, where poplar, mulberry, apricot, peach, apple, and plum trees burst out into a colourful riot with orange, rust, and red hues. The calm weather with bracing provides the best view of the surrounding mountains.

Including in the itinerary, you will have a mild taste of the capital city of Pakistan, **Islamabad** and the vibrant city of **Lahore** – exudes culture at every corner.

DAY 02 ABBOTTABAD – GILGIT

21 Oct Drive to Gilgit on the Karakoram Highway

Packed lunch

Most of the journey today would be on the **great Karakoram Highway**, considered to be the 8<sup>th</sup> wonder of the world.



It is a long drive (avg 12 hours) through scenic mountains, villages, passing through small street bazaar like Pattan & Batgram. Going through slowly these busy street bazaars on your coach is quite interesting.

We will need to go through the Tourist Information Registration Process near to CHILAS police check point.

Dinner at a local restaurant upon along the way.

# DAY 03 22Oct

#### **GILGIT - ATTABAD LAKE / Ghulkin village**

After breakfast, we will drive towards the **upper Hunza** 

Photo-stop at the remaining of **OLD SILK Road Chalt** and the 7<sup>th</sup> highest mountain in Pakistan and 27<sup>th</sup> in the world – the famous **Mt RAKAPOSHI** from view points.



Continue the drive to upper Hunza.

Lunch @ a local village homestay (our operator's parents' house up in the mountain, accessable only by 4WD.

After lunch, continue to explore the **village of Ghulkin, Gulmit + Passu Glazier** Dinner @ Khunjerav café with fried fish.

Arrive Attabad Famree Resort, over looking the Attabad Lake to overnite.

#### DAY 04 23 Oct

#### ATTTABAD - SOST - KHUNJERAB PASS - PASSU - HUNZA (Karimabad)

Morning – *optional*: for you to take a 20 min boat ride in Attabad lake, near to your hotel on your own expenses.

Today, we shall drive to the **Khunjerab Pass** (4693m)—the border between Pakistan & China), passing thru' the landport town of **SOST.** 



Photo stop along the way @ **Passu** and take a challenge walk across the Hussaini suspension footbridge on the return journey from Khunjerab Pass.



Continue to drive to Karimabad (central HUNZA)

Dinner @ the hotel restaurant.

**DAY 05** 

Hunza

24 Oct

We will have a full day to explore the beautiful central HUNZA.

Spend some time at **Hooper Glazier + Nagar Valley** 

The Hooper is the main village of Nagar Valley and is one of the most scenic part of the Nagar Valley. **Hooper village** is the home of the Spantik and Hooper Glacier....we will take a mild hike to view the Hooper Glacier.

# DAY 07 26 Oct

# **DUIKAR – GILGIT- GUPIS (Ghizer Valley)**

Early morning, from your hotel to watch the rising sun over the snow-capped mountains OR you may hike up again to the top to take a better view over **HUNZA valley** in the morning light........ After breakfast, check out and we shall drive to Gilgit .

Lunch @ Gilgit town.





Take a scenic drive to **Gupis** with photo stops along the way / Bridge / Villages / River Dinner @ Gahkuch

DAY 08 27 Oct **GUPIS – Yasin Village – Khalti Lake – GILGIT** 

Your hotel @ Blossom INN may not be of a good standard hotel to many travellers, however, the view surrounding this hotel is very scenic, especially with blue sky.

After breakfast, we shall drive to visit yet another interesting village – **Yasin Village** for its autumn colour

On the way back to Gilgit, we shall visit the **Khalti Lake** which is 2217 meter above sea level and is known for its' habitat of trout fish. The lake is in bend of the **Ghizer River** near to the village of Khalti.



Thereafter, will proceed the journey towards **upper Gahkuch**, a beautiful village for a village walk. Moving forward the journey continues to **Gilgit** (approx.. 03 hours)

DAY 09 28 Oct

#### **GILGIT- KHAPHU**

We will take the road known as **Strategic highway** 1, starts on the Karakoram Highway towards Skardu district.

Here, we will have a stop to view **Karakoram Mountains**, **Nanga Parbat**, **the Himalaya mountains** range.

This Strategic roads runs along **the River Indus**, the road is slightly winding, in some places only wide enough for one vehicle, and in many places bordered by a drop of hundreds of meters unprotected by guardrails.

We will stop at Skardu for lunch and continue the scenic road to **Khaphu**......various photo-stop along the way.

SKARDU - ISLAMABAD by flight

#### We will take a domestic flight from SKARDU to Islamabad

(flight from Skardu (Gilgit – Baltistan) to Islamabad is subject to weather, in case of flight cancellation by the authority, the group will have to drive all the way back to Islamabad by our coach, the group need to overnight in CHILAS(half-way) before continue to Islamabad)

Upon arriving Islamabad by flight, we shall proceed to have our lunch before driving to visit the Taxila Museum . Taxila Museum has one of the most significant and comprehensive collection of stone Buddhist sculpture from the first to the seventh centuires in Pakistan known as Gandharan art. The core of the collection comes from excavated sites in the Taxila valley, particularly the excavations of sir John Marshall.

# Points to take note:

Some places covered by the itinerary are remote, with limited facilities and amenities. We have selected one of the better hotels in most places, however, some accommodation standard would be basic but clean. One must be prepared that most accommodation do not have lifts services. The hotel staffs will help to delivery your big bag to your room and to our coach when we checked out. Power failure is quite a common issue in the remote areas.

Huge temperature gap between day and night, strong UV rays

Weather: Autumn between -05 to 13C Northern Pakistan Islamabad / Lahore average 27C day time

Travel in high elevation areas, long distance drive & some mountainous road pose uncertainties including unpredictable weather, road blocked due to landslide or other reasons, political situation, policy changes, burny road etc. Tour itinerary may be subject to change in response to various uncertainties, all tour members should be mentally prepared to accept changes and be understanding and have an open-mind to unforeseen circumstance which is beyond our and local operator's control during the tour.

Additional cost might be incurred due to unforeseen calamity (acts of god) during the tour or if government imposes a new fee or new condition resulting extra charges during the tour which is beyond our control. Such additional cost will be shared equally amongst all paying passengers on board at the point of time, if applicable.

The autumn season normally begins from mid of Oct to 3<sup>rd</sup> week of November depending on areas & altitude.
