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7D6N FEB 9 – 15 & FEB 16 – 22, 2023 UNSEEN Mountain Route to Chiang Rai

D1 THU: Chiang Mai - Chiang Dao



Transfer to Chiang Dao. Visit Chiang Dao Cave (famous cave with shrines inside), Wat Tham Pha Plong (a forest monastery established by venerated monk, the late

Luang Pu Sim), **Makhampon Art Space Café** (a creatively landscaped and decorated gathering spot for local artists and art activities) and **Wat Mae Ead** (famous for statues depicting punishments in hell). Overnight in Chiang Dao.

D2 FRI: Chiang Dao - Muang Ngai - Wiang Heang - Piang Luang (B)



After breakfast, leave Chiang Dao and transfer to visit **Wat Pa Thara Phirom** (a forest temple with Khmer influenced temple buildings), **Muang Ngai Naresuan Shrine** (with a replica of the fort King Naresuan built when he stopped here on his way to attack Burma) and **Wat Phra That Doi Pu Kam** (enjoy the stunning hilltop views).


Then to Wat Phra That Doi Mon Ching (with a golden rock shrine like Myanmar's Golden Rock). Transfer along Route 1322 (Mae Ja

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Arrival in Wiang Haeng to visit **Wiang Haeng Naresuan Shrine** (King Naresuan is believed to have passed away here in 1605 after falling seriously ill) and **Wat Wiang Haeng** (with locally revered Phra Chao San Sae Buddha statue, over 500 years old). Then continue to Tambon Saen Hai to visit **Wat Borommathat Saen Hai** (with the most revered pagoda of the locals). Overnight in Piang Luang.

D3 SAT: Piang Luang - Ban Arunothai - Doi Angkhang (B)



Early morning, transfer to Piang Luang View Point to view Sea of Clouds. After breakfast, visit Piang Luang Saturday Morning Market. If routes are open, visit some Lisu & Palaung villages in the area. Visit Wat Fa Wiang In (a temple which has a section located within Myanmar territory), Tomb of General Mo Heng (founder of the Shan United Revolutionary Army, involved in insurgency against Burma's military government from 1960 to 1996) and the White Sitting Buddha.



Transfer along **Route 1778 (Piang Luang to Arunothai)**, stopping at **Kae Noi** (with old KMT Yunnan style houses and Chinese tombs on hill slopes). At **Ban Muang Na**, visit **Wat Phuttha Phrom Panyo** (temple founded by Luang Ta Ma, a disciple of venerated late Luang Pu Du).

Arrival Ban Arunothai (a village consisting of descendants of former Kuomintang soldiers from Yunnan; recommended lunch here is Yunnan Noodles). Visit Wat Arunothai, Nong Uk Lake & Swamp Café and Kew Pha Wok Border Checkpoint.

Transfer to visit **First Royal Project Factory Museum** (dedicated to Royal initiative projects for sustainable development of "Sufficiency Economy"). Overnight in Doi Angkhang area.

D4 SUN: Doi Angkhang - Fang - Tha Ton (B)













After Early morning, transfer to **Mon Son Viewpoint for sunrise viewing**. Back to hotel for breakfast. Transfer to visit **Doi Angkhang Royal Project Station**, **Doi Angkhang Pagoda**, **Ban Nor Lae Strawberry Farm** (by Palaung people),

Koob Dong Village (Black Lahu village) and Fang Hot Springs.









Arrival Fang town to visit Phra Chao Fang & Phra Nang Sam Phio Monument (a local ruler & his queen who gave their lives so that the Burmese do not destroy Fang city), Wat Tong Rung and Wat Jong Pan (both fine examples of Shan style temples). From Mae Ai, take detour to Route 1314 (mountain border road) with stop at Wat Pang Ton Duea Samakkhitham (with views over the area), Sabaidee Coffee Doi Lang and Doi Kiew Hung Viewpoint. Arrival Tha Ton to overnight.

D5 MON: Tha Ton - Mae Salong (B)







After breakfast, visit **Wat Tha Ton**, including reaching to top level main chedi and the golden standing Buddha. Enjoy views overlooking Kok River and the Tha Ton Bridge.





Visit **Thanathorn Orchard** and then **Home Pan Din Vineyard**. Transfer to **Mae Salong**, a tea growing village of descendants of former Kuomintang soldiers from Yunnan.







Visit Mae Salong Martyr's Memorial (learn about Mae Salong's history) and Phra Borom Mahathat Srinagarindra Maha Santikhiri Chedi. Then visit Choui Fong Tea Plantation (including stop at their architecture award winning café). Overnight in Mae Salong.

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D6 TUE: Mae Salong - Doi Tung - Mae Sai - Chiang Rai (B)



After breakfast, visit **Doi Tung Palace & Gardens** (former residence of the late Princess Mother, the mother of the late King Bhumibol; she was instrumental in bringing much prosperity to the ethnic minorities of the mountain areas), **Wat Phra That Doi Tung** (with twin stupas of Lanna style; this is the pilgrimage temple for those born under the "Pig" zodiac), **Mae Fah Luang Arboretum**, **Chang Moob Military Outpost** (with views overlooking Myanmar) and stop at **Phamuang Coffee**.



Then to Pha Hi
Village Bamboo

and Pha Mee
village (enjoy
views from the

café, the coffee beans are locally grown here by the Akha ethnic minority).



Then to **Tham Luang – Khun Nang Nam Nong National Park** to visit **Tham Luang Cave** (where the dramatic rescue of the trapped 12 boys & their football coach occurred), **Chao Mae Nang Non shrine**, the **Rescue Museum** & **Khun Nam Nang Non swamp**). Stop at **Mae Sai** town, which is the northernmost point of Thailand and a border market opposite Myanmar's Tachilek town. Transfer to **Chiang Rai Night Bazaar**. Overnight in Chiang Rai.

D7 WED: Chiang Rai Airport - Chiang Mai Airport - Chiang Mai (B)

After breakfast, 8am transfer to Chiang Rai airport (drop off paxs) and 9am, transfer to Chiang Mai Airport (drop off paxs; 3.10pm flight departure) and Chiang Mai city (drop off paxs).
