#### Day 1 Explore the 9<sup>th</sup> Century Prambanan Temple

1415 Visit **Prambanan Temple, UNESCO World Heritage Site**, a ninth century Hindu temple compound dedicated to Trimurti; the expression of God as Creator (Brahma), Sustainer (Vishnu) and Destroyer (Shiva).  
1700 Check-in hotel in Jogjakarta for 3-nights  
1900 **Enjoy Indo Buffet Dinner at Gazebo Garden Restaurant\***  
2000 **Watch the Ramayana Ballet Cultural Show\***  
2200 Back at hotel to overnight.

#### Day 2 Explore the 9<sup>th</sup> Century Borobudur Temple

- 0700 Enjoy Breakfast at hotel  
0800 Travel to Borobudur Temple, 1h30m, 43km  
1000 Explore **UNESCO World Heritage Borobudur Temple**, a 9th century Buddhist stupa which is the largest stupa in the world.  
1300 **Enjoy Indonesian Set Lunch at BS Restaurant**  
1430 Uncover the 8<sup>th</sup> century heritage, **Pawon Temple**  
1530 Discover the 9<sup>th</sup> century Buddhist **Mendut Temple**  
1600 Visit **Mendut Buddhist Monastery**  
1630 Travel back to Jogjakarta, 1h30m, 43km  
1830 **Enjoy Sunda Set Dinner at Sintawang Restaurant**  
2100 Back at hotel to overnight.
