# 4D3N Hua Hin + Prachuap

(with 1 Day Trip to Khao Sam Roi Yot National Park including visiting **Pavilion of Phraya Nakhon Cave**; & Prachuap Khiri Khan seaside provincial capital)



## DAY 1: Hua Hin arrival

11.10am arrival Hua Hin airport. Transfer for lunch at food court of Market Place Mall (lunch on own budget). Proceed for city tour including **Royal Train Station** (a classic design dating from 1910), **Fisherman village at Khao Takiab hill** (visit the **standing Buddha** statue), Ferry Pier, Sea Pine Beach and **Royal Park of Kings**.

4.30pm transfer to hotel for check-in.

6.30pm transfer for seafood dinner at Bird Chilli Restaurant (dinner on own budget) and then visit Hua **Hin Night Market**.  
Overnight in Hua Hin.

### **DAY 2: Hua Hin + Day Trip to Khao Sam Roi Yot National Park & Prachuap Khiri Khan town (B)**

8am Depart hotel and transfer to Khao Sam Roi Yot National Park  
9.30am Arrival at Khao Sam Roi Yot National Park. "Khao Sam Roi Yot" means Mountain of 3 Hundred Peaks, referring to many limestone peaks there. Visit the **fisherman village** that is located inside the national park along a river and surrounded by limestone peaks.

Take a boat to the secluded **Laem Sala Beach**. From the beach, a trail leads to the **Phraya Nakhon Cave**, the highlight of your trip to Khao Sam Roi Yot National Park. Inside the cave is the **Khuha Kharuehat Pavilion** which was built for King Chulalongkorn (Rama V) when the King visited the cave in 1890. At certain times during certain months, the sun will shine directly on it. The pavilion has since become the **symbol of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province**. Later kings also visited the cave, including King Vajiravudh (Rama VI) and King Bhumibol Adulyadej (Rama IX).

12pm Visit the **Thung Sam Roi Yot** fresh water marsh, the largest fresh water marsh in Thailand.

Then transfer to Prachuap Khiri Khan town, the province's capital.

1.30pm Lunch at restaurant (on own budget) overlooking **Prachuap Bay**.

2.30pm Visit **City Pillar Shrine, Saran Withi Bridge** (pier that stretch out to the Gulf of Thailand), **Wat Ao Noi Teak Temple** (intricate carvings on its teak structure) and **Wat Thammikaran on Khao Chong Krajok hill** (be rewarded by grand views overlooking the sea and the town). Then return back to your hotel in Hua Hin.

6.30pm Depart for **Hua Hin Night bazaar** for shopping and dinner on your own budget.

9.30pm Back to hotel to overnight.

### **DAY 3: Hua Hin (B)**

9.30am, pick up from hotel to visit **Mrigadayavan Palace** (seaside teak palace built in 1924 by King Vajiravudh; Rama VI) and **Plearnwan Market**, an open air mall built to 1950s theme (Lunch on own budget here; alternatively, you can also eat at food court of Market Place Mall).

Then visit **Wat Huay Mongkhon** (with giant statue of famous monk, Luang Por Thuat) and then **Hua Hin Winery Yard**.

4.30pm transfer back to hotel to freshen up.

6.30pm Visit **Cicada Market & Tamarind Market** (Dinner on own budget).

Overnight in Hua Hin.

### **DAY 4: Hua Hin departure (B)**

After breakfast, 9am transfer to airport for 11.40am departure flight.
