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# 4D3N HANOI & HALONG BAY



## DAY 1: HANOI ARRIVAL (-/-/-)

Upon arrival at Noi Bai International airport, meet up your representative and transfer for sightseeing at **Tran Quoc Pagoda**, **Hoan Kiem Lake** and **Hanoi Opera**. Then to **36 Ancient Street area in Hanoi Old Quarter** and free shopping at **Dong Xuan market**, **Hang Gai**, **Hang Dao**, **Hang Ngang**, etc.; with hundreds of specialty shops selling silk clothing, lacquerware, embroidered linens, furniture, cooking utensils, etc. Meals on your own budget. **Overnight in Hanoi**.

### DAY 2: HANOI HALF DAY CITY TOUR – HALONG (B/L/-)

Start your half day city tour with the **Ho Chi Minh Complex**, where the father of modern-day Vietnam declared the nation's independence in 1945. Continue your tour at sites such as the **Stilt House, Presidential Palace, and One Pillar Pagoda.** Then visit the **Temple of Literature**, the first University in Vietnam. Transfer to Halong, check in hotel, the rest of day is at your own leisure. Dinner on your own budget in Halong city area. **Overnight in Ha Long.** 

**Note:** Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (the inside) will be opened only in the morning. It will be closed every Monday and Friday. Besides the outside of Ho chi Minh Mausoleum, you can still visit Ba Dinh square, Presidential Palace, Ho Chi Minh's House on stilt, One pillar pagoda as normal







### DAY 3: HALONG - HANOI (B/L/-)

After breakfast, start your 3 - 4 hour boat trip of UNESCO World Heritage Halong Bay. Walk into the **Thien Cung cave (Paradise Palace cave)** to see thousands of stalactites and stalagmites colored by hundreds of neon lights. Then back to the boat for cruising Halong Bay to see the **Incense Bowl islet, Cock fighting islets, Sail islet, Turtle island**, etc. A delicious seafood lunch will be served while you relax on the boat. At 12 noon, you finish your boat trip and transfer back to Hanoi with stopover at Ceramic and Hand Embroidery Workshop en-route. Around 5pm, back in Hanoi for own leisure time. Dinner on your own budget. **Overnight in Hanoi**.

### **DAY 4: HANOI DEPARTURE**

(B/-/-)

Free time for relax and shopping until your transfer to the airport for your onward flight.
