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# **4D3N Solo to Semarang**

(Tue or Thu departures)



**BEST TIME TO VISIT:** Solo & Semarang are in Central Java province, Java island. Best to visit during dry season, May to Oct. Avoid going during Hari Raya Puasa as many businesses and tourism services shut down. Left: Rainfall chart for Solo.

# DAY 1: SOLO arrival - Candi Ceto & Candi Sukuh – SOLO

(L/D)



After lunch, transfer to visit **Candi Ceto** and **Candi Sukuh**; both are 15th century Hindu temples located on the western slope of Mount Lawu, on the border between Central and East Java provinces. Candi Ceto has a impressive Javanese styled stone gate while Candi Sukuh is famous for its erotic carvings of sexual nature. Return to Solo to overnight.

## DAY 2 : SOLO - Banaran Coffee - Candi Gedong Songo - SEMARANG (B/L/D)



Morning, visit **Mangkunegaran Palace** (of Mangkunegoro royal family) and **Klewer market** (famous for wide range of batik cloth).

After lunch, transfer to **Banaran Coffee Plantation** (opening hours 9am to 4pm) to learn about coffee and cocoa agriculture and enjoy the cool highland air.



Then to **Candi Gedong Songo**, a Hindu temple with origins dated between the 8th and 9th centuries. Similar with temples on Dieng Plateau (west of Jogjakarta), it was erected out of volcanic stone and both complexes represent the oldest Hindu structures in Java (older tha Borobudur and Prambanan). Arrival and overnight in Semarang.



Semarang is the capital of Central Java province. Visit Old Dutch area (including visit Gereja Blenduk church & Stesen Tawang train station), Tugu Muda, Lawang Sewu Building, Sam Po Kong temple, MGM (Marabunta) Theater and Semarang Central Mosque. Then visit Nyonya Meneer - traditional Jamu (Javanese Herbal Medicine) factory (opening hours 9am to 3.30pm). Shopping at Pandanaran street. Overnight in Semarang.



#### DAY 4: SEMARANG departure (B)

Transfer to Semarang airport for 8.55am Air Asia flight home.
