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DAY 1: Bangkok arrival – Kanchanaburi

(L/D)



Arrive Bangkok, meet and transfer to **Kanchanaburi**, the riverside town where the River Kwai Bridge is located. During Second World War, the Thai-Myanmar Railway was constructed by the

Japanese Army using forced Asian labour and captured prisoners of war. Many of them perished and the railway line is called the 'Death Railway'. Visit the **War Museum, Allied War Cemetery, Thai-Myanmar Railway Centre Museum** and the **River Kwai Bridge**. Check in hotel in Kanchanaburi to overnight.

DAY 2: Kanchanaburi – Ayutthaya

(B/L/D)



Check out from hotel and transfer to Kanchanaburi train station to board **train for journey across River Kwai Bridge**, along **Death Railway** and passing scenic **Krasae Cave** section. Then proceed to **Hellfire Pass Memorial**, a section of the Death Railway preserved for tourists; this was where many Allied prisoners of war worked and died under harsh conditions and brutal Japanese treatment. Thereafter, head to

Ayutthaya and check in hotel to overnight.

DAY 3: Ayutthaya – Bang Pa In – Bangkok

(B/L/D)



Check out from hotel and begin tour of **UNESCO World Heritage Ayutthaya**, the ancient capital of the Ayutthaya Kingdom (1351-1767 AD). Visit **Wat Chaiwattanam** (with its unique Khmer style architecture), **Viharn Mongkhon Bopit**, **Wat Phra Si Sanphet**, **Wat Mahathat** (look for the head of Buddha encapsulated by tree roots), **Wat Yai Chaimongkon** and **Elephant Kraal** (the enclosure where elephants are trained during Ayutthaya period). Transfer back to Bangkok with en-route visit of **Bang Pa In Summer Palace**, the royal summer palace with beautiful landscaping and mix of Thai, Chinese & Western style buildings. Arrival in Bangkok and check in hotel to overnight.

DAY 4: Railway Market, Floating Market & Phra Pathom chedi day trip

Early departure to visit one of the most bizarre & unique market in the world; the **Mae Klong Railway Market** (where vendors lay their wares over the railway track and quickly withdraws them when the train approaches!). Continue to the **Damneon Saduak Floating Market** which includes boat ride along canals. Afternoon, visit **Phra Pathom Chedi**, the tallest Buddhist stupa in the world. Thereafter, return back to your hotel in Bangkok. Evening, free at your own leisure (Dinner on your own). Overnight in Bangkok.
