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### DAY 1: Phnom Penh – Kep

(L/D)

7.35am flight arrival **Phnom Penh** airport. Transfer to Takeo Province to visit the ruins of the 11th century mountain-top temple-fortress of **Phnom Chisor**. Then continue south to the coast and the delightful scenic coastal town of **Kep**. Go for a stroll along the waterfront to visit the famous crab market. Enjoy dinner by seaside including crab dish. Overnight in Kep.

### DAY 2: Kep - Bokor – Sihanoukville

(B/L/D)

Transfer to **Bokor**, located on top of a mountain range, to visit the abandoned buildings of this former **colonial French Hill station (the church, the casino, the old hotel, etc.)**, **Popokvil Falls** and enjoy the wonderful view from the mountain cliff over jungle towards the coastline. Transfer to **Sihanoukville** beach resort town, check-in hotel and leisure time at the beach. Overnight in Sihanoukville.

**DAY 3: Sihanoukville - Kompong Chnang – Battambang (B/L/D)**

Morning, city & beach sight seeing drive around Sihanoukville. Then departure for the fascinating river port town of **Kompong Chnang**. Tour of the bustling town and markets on foot and by boat - since **half the town is actually floating on the Tonle Sap River!** In the afternoon, transfer to **Battambang**, Cambodia's 2nd largest city to overnight.

**DAY 4: Battambang – Sangker River Boat Cruise - Siem Reap (B/L/D)**

Morning ride through the rural countryside on **Battambang's famous 'bamboo train'** and short **city tour of Battambang**. Transfer to visit 11th century Angkorian period temple, **Ek Phnom**. Then start scenic **boat journey on Sangker River**, weaving past riverside villages and rice fields, before entering the huge **Tonle Sap Lake**. Cruise past **Prek Toal bird sanctuary** and the **'flooded forest'**; with a stop to visit the **Prek Toal community water hyacinth weaving project**. Arrival in **Siem Reap** to overnight.

**DAY 5: Siem Reap departure (B)**

Transfer to Siem Reap airport for 8.35am flight home.

**RATES:** per person, twin sharing, based on group sizes below, valid till Apr 2016. Surcharge may apply for peak periods like X'Mas-New Year, Khmer New Year, etc.
