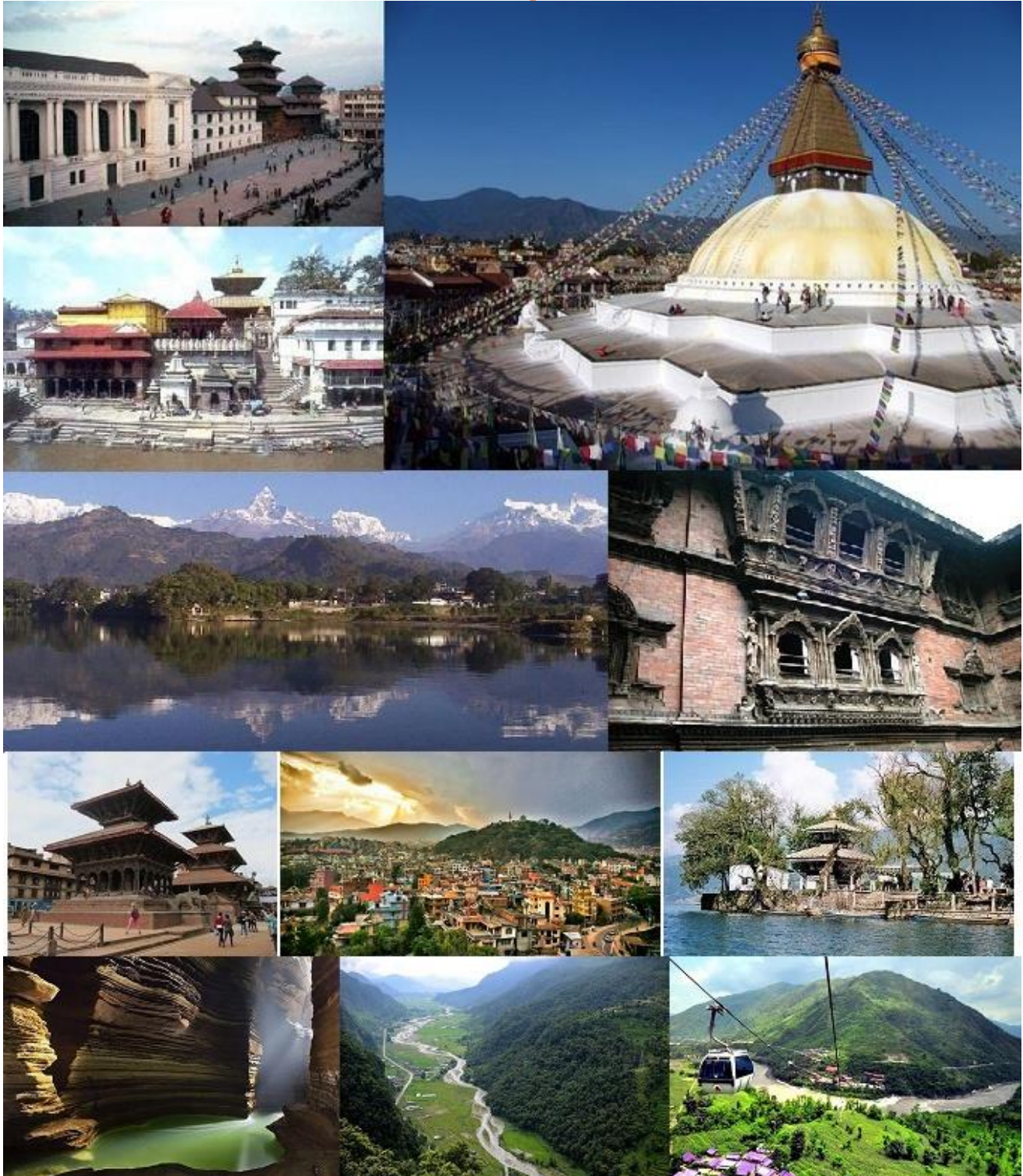


# NEPAL 6D5N Sep 13-18 Malaysia Day Holiday

Other travel dates can be arranged

## Kathmandu, Patan, Bhaktapur & Pokhara





### DAY 1: Kathmandu arrival

(D)



Air Asia arrival **Kathmandu** 1.30pm. Visit **UNESCO World Heritage Kathmandu Durbar** (Royal Palace square - site of the Hanuman Dhoka Palace Complex, which was the royal Nepalese residence until the 19th century) and **Kumari Chowk** (home of Kumari, a young girl chosen through an ancient and mystical selection process to become the human

incarnation of the Hindu mother goddess Durga). Evening, welcome dinner with live **Nepalese culture show**. Overnight in Kathmandu.

### DAY 2: Kathmandu – Patan - Kathmandu

(B/L/D)



Visit **UNESCO World Heritage Swayambhunath** (the 5th-century Buddhist stupa on a hill overlooking the Kathmandu Valley with great views of Kathmandu), **UNESCO World Heritage Pashupatinath** (Lord Shiva shrine; among the holiest Hindu shrine in the world) and **Patan City** for the **UNESCO World Heritage Patan Durbar square** and the **Tibetan Refugee camp**. Overnight in Kathmandu.

### DAY 3: Kathmandu – Pokhara

(B/L/D)

Transfer to **Pokhara** by road.



**OPTIONAL: Manakamana Temple USD20 /adult and USD15/child.**

En-route to Pokhara, visit Manakamana Temple, located on top of a hill. It is the sacred place of the Hindu Goddess Bhagwati, an incarnation of Parvati. The name Manakamana originates from two words, “mana” meaning heart and “kamana” meaning wish; since it is believed the Goddess grants the wishes of all those who make the pilgrimage to her shrine to worship her. Includes return cable car ticket.



Arrival in Pokhara, Nepal 2<sup>nd</sup> most populous city after Kathmandu and scenically located in a valley just 15 to 35 miles from the Annapurna Mountain Range. Go for boating trip to the **Bahiri Temple** located in the middle of **Phewa Lake**, the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest lake in Nepal and the only one with a temple in the middle of a lake. Overnight in Pokhara.



### DAY 4: Pokhara

(B/L)

Visit **Vindhyavashini temple** located in the old bazaar area. Next is **Mahendra Cave**. Proceed to visit **Seti Gandaki River Gorge** (the Seti Gandaki river “White River” flows through Pokhara and together with its tributaries, carves many beautiful gorges and canyons around Pokhara). Continue to **Devi's waterfall** (whose water form an underground tunnel), followed by **Gupteswore Mahadev**

**Cave** (with a shrine dedicated to Shiva). Lastly, visit **Lake Begnash**. Dinner on your own; Pokhara being a magnet for tourists, has many restaurants serving diverse cuisines. Overnight in Pokhara.

**DAY 5: Pokhara – Kathmandu**

**(B/L)**



Morning departure by road to **Kathmandu**. Arrival in Kathmandu and visit **UNESCO World Heritage Boudhanath** (among the largest Buddhist stupas of South Asia, surrounded by a “Little Tibet” community). Dinner on your own. Overnight in Kathmandu.

**DAY 6: Kathmandu – Bhaktapur - departure**

**(B/L)**



Morning, visit **UNESCO World Heritage Bhaktapur Durbar Square**. Proceed for lunch. Then transfer to airport for Air Asia 3.15pm flight home.

**RATES:** per person, based on twin sharing basis, according to group sizes and hotel options as below; for SEP 2018 to NOV 2018 travel period.
