

## 2D1N SUNFLOWER FIELDS & KHAO YAI

**DAILY DEPARTURES: DEC 29 until JAN 7**

### DAY 1: Bangkok – Patthana Nikhom – Khao Yai



Morning, pick up from your hotel in Pratunam Area of Bangkok and transfer to the **Sunflower Fields of Patthana Nikhom** of Lopburi province. The sunflower blooms from December to January annually; the farmers who grow them take turns to harvest their fields so that there are always flowers for tourists to enjoy. Then to **Pasak Chonlasit Dam's viewpoint**; the biggest reservoir in Central Thailand.



Transfer to **Khao Yai** area of Nakhon Ratchasima (Khorat) province, with lunch stop en-route (lunch on your own budget). Khao Yai is located in a highland plateau, with agro-tourism attractions and has long been a cool weekend escape for Bangkok city dwellers. Visit **PB Winery for vineyard visit and enjoy the 3pm wine tasting session**. Visit **The Bloom Garden**, with flower gardens for photography. Check in your hotel in Khao Yai. Dinner on your own budget. Overnight in Khao Yai.

### DAY 2: Khao Yai – Jim Thompson Farm - National Park – Bangkok (B)



Morning, transfer to visit **Jim Thompson Farm (usually open early DEC to early JAN)**, which started as a mulberry farm and silkworm production facility for Jim Thompson silk textile & clothing company; now a popular agro-tourism attraction open to public for a limited period yearly, with many flower fields on show and fruits & vegetables for sale. Lunch on own budget at Jim Thompson Farm.

**NOTE:** *If Jim Thompson Farm is closed, tour group will visit **Flora Park**, flower gardens attraction located in Wang Nam Khiao District.*



Then transfer to visit **UNESCO World Heritage Khao Yai National Park** to visit **Km. 30 Viewpoint, Visitor Centre, Haew Suwat Waterfall** (appeared in the movie "The Beach" starring **Leonardo**

**DiCaprio**), **Saisorn Reservoir, Spirit House, Pha Diew Dai Viewpoint** and **Haew Narok Waterfall**.

Transfer back to Bangkok and drop off at your hotel in Bangkok.

*Anyone extending stay in **UNESCO World Heritage Ayutthaya**, then drop off at hotel in Ayutthaya. **Ayutthaya tour package** can be arranged for you.*
