Or, partake in a tour of the city's highlights, including Nuremberg Castle, an impressive medieval complex in the heart of the historical center. Next, visit Roth and explore the Jewish culture and its role in German history.

DAY 6: Straubing, Deggendorf, Vilshofen

Aside from its' stunning architecture and panoramic views of Wachau Valley below, its interior boasts pure opulence in every room. There's nothing like it.
